# 4. Drop-Off and Pick-Up by Parents who drive

- If you are driving your child to school, between 7.00 a.m. and 7.30 a.m., please drop off your child at the designated alighting point in front of the school's porch. Please be considerate to other drivers by getting your child ready to alight quickly and safely, when you stop at the alighting point. As you exit the school gate, please be patient and <u>turn left</u> as vehicles are not allowed to turn right between 7.00 am to 7.45 am from Mon to Fri.
- If you are driving to pick up your child from school at dismissal time, please <u>do not</u> drive into the school premises as the school buses are waiting for our students in the carpark. Parents are strongly encouraged to park their vehicles at nearby public carparks and take a short walk to school to pick children up. For safety reasons, you are advised not to park your vehicle along the main road to wait for your child. In the event of wet weather, parents will be allowed to drive into the school compound to fetch their children <u>only after</u> all the school buses have left.
